Meeting opened with prayer by Pastor Scott. Meeting called to order by Moderator Bill Johnson in absence of the Chair and Vice-chair. Minutes of May 11 meeting were accepted as presented. (Dallas, Howard) Treasurer report:

- > Take collection plate to alter for offering
- > Have candlelighter close the candles on Altar during last hymn

> Open doors to sanctuary at the end of church service

- > Make sure all thermostats are set back
- > Change banner and alter cloth for next week
- > Turn off two lamps on podium
- > Make sure sound system is off
- > Veteran's donation jar removed
- > Doorbell returned to plugin
- > Make sure all lighted pictures and display case are turned off
- > Make sure all of the lights are off including restrooms

> Make sure all doors are locked before leaving

## **Communion Sunday**

> Get communion elements for pastor and congregation ready

> Clean up communion elements up after church – outside not down drain

> Make sure there is a supply of communion elements for pastor and congregation for future worship services

## Ice Cream in a Bag

1 cup half and half OR ½ cup whole milk and ½ cup cream 1/2 tsp imitation vanilla extract 1 tbsp sugar ice 1/4 cup salt Ziploc bags 1 Small, 1 Large

Pour 1 cup of half and half into a small Ziploc bag. Add ½ TSP of vanilla extract and 1 TBSP of sugar. Seal the bag firmly and get any excess air out.

In the larger Ziploc bag, fill it about  $\frac{1}{2}$  way with ice. Add  $\frac{1}{4}$  cup of salt.

Place your small bag into the big bag and fill with extra ice on top. Seal the large bag. Shake bag for 6 minutes.

Take the small bag out of the large bag and rinse the outside of the small bag with cold water. Make sure to rinse the seal so salt does not enter the small bag when you open it.

The ice cream will be a little icy looking to start. Use a spoon to mix it around and soften it up a little bit.

Scoop out and enjoy!
